This isn't just a day of fun and discovery! Brownies will complete many skills for the Senses Badge, Juniors for the Detective Badge, Cadettes for the Special Agent Badge, and Seniors can check off steps toward the Truth Seeker Badge.

Design Challenge
Join us for our first state fair design challenge. Girls will be given a box of supplies and will use the supplies to create something that fits the theme within a certain time limit.

Float Decorating Contest
Troops can submit a design/theme for decorating the float used by Girl Scouts during the daily state fair parade. The committee will choose the winning design and the winning troop will decorate the float the weekend before the fair opens on July 24. The winning troop will receive a cash prize of \$100, additional money for supplies, and recognition on the float.

Patches!
Anyone visiting the Girl Scout exhibit area can purchase a commemorative patch. Enter a project in the fair AND march in one of the parades to satisfy the key requirements to earn a special patch available only at the fair. *The remaining earned patch requirements can be completed in a one day visit to the fair.*
