Patch Program Helping Troops Grow Strong

A successful Girl Scout troop needs more than adult volunteers putting all the troop pieces together. Each troop needs the involvement of the girls and the girls' families. A successful Girl Scout experience needs more than a girl on her own. She needs the support and excitement of her family.

The patch program, "Families of the Heartland," guides families on how they can help strengthen a troop or make individual Girl Scout experiences fantastic.

A Girl Scout must have at least one adult family member or friend help them make the troop or her experiences grow strong by completing the requirements listed during the course of one membership year (October 1 - September 30).

Upon completion, fill out the order form and either have your troop leader verify that you completed the requirements or sign that you have completed these with your individually registered Girl Scout.

You can then send in your order form with payment or visit a store to receive your recognition. There are two forms of recognition available: a patch for the Girl Scout to wear on the back of her sash or vest and a window cling for the family car or home.

Participating adults must complete one of the starred activities plus two others or five of the non-starred activities.

You can think of your own activity to help, too! It will count as a non-starred activity.
