Program Overview – Earn Your Foot

About the YEA! Toe Program:

The "You're Environmentally Aware! (YEA!) Toe" program has been helping participants learn more about their environmental surroundings for several decades. The program aim for girls to learn about different parts of the environment so they can learn to minimize their "footprint". Each toe is an important part of making sure that we have a strong natural environment for years to come!

How the Program Works:

- 1. First you must earn your Foot by completing the game included in this packet.
- 2. Decide which "YEA! Toe" you would like to complete.
- 3. Find out what "YEA! Toes" are available.
- 4. Complete the program that is outlined in the program kit
- 5. Once you have completed all the required activities for the Toe you are working on, you may purchase the Toe from the Council Shop

Materials:

- ☐ Recycled Materials to make a spinner or dice
- ☐ The Leave No Trace playing spaces (included in this packet)
- ☐ A large space

Key Principles:

★ Introduction to being Environmentally Aware

Directions:

- ★Lay out all the game spaces so that they make a game board.
- ★Each girl takes a turn. Try to make a dice, or spinner out of recycled materials (Cardboard, milk cartons, etc. work great!)
- ★Once they have landed on a space, that space will tell them what they will do for that turn.. (EX. YEA! You remembered to disperse your toothpaste water instead of just spitting it out on the ground, move ahead 4 spaces.)
- ★Then the next girl takes a turn.
- ★Make sure you keep going until all girls have reached the end, and reiterate that this in not a game about winning, but about learning practices that help them to be environmentally aware!

You took newspapers and aluminum cans to the recycling center!





Go Ahead 3 spaces

Girl Scouts make the world a better place!

You picked up someone else's candy wrapper and put it in the garbage!





Go Ahead 4 spaces

Girl Scouts leave a place better than they found it!

You had a cookout and didn't use aluminum foil because you learned it takes 30 years to decompose!

Go Ahead 3 spaces

Girl Scouts think about their choices!

Oh NO!

You threw your chewing gum on the ground.





Go Back 1 space

Girl Scouts don't litter!

You recycled your lunch bag by using the same one all week!





Go Ahead 3 spaces

Girl Scouts reuse supplies when they can!

You brought a litter bag on the trip to carry all of your garbage and other garbage people left behind!





Go Ahead 1 spaces

Girl Scouts help others!

You touched poison ivy because you didn't know what it was.

Now you itch all over!





Lose a Turn

Girl Scouts know what to look out for.

You rode your bike instead of having someone drive you to the library!

Girl Scouts use resources wisely!

Your troop found an interesting tree and did research to find out all it!





Go Ahead 2 spaces

Girl Scouts learn new things!

You brought your dog to camp and it chased all the squirrels away!





Go Back 2 spaces

Girl Scouts leave their pets at home.

You built your fire in an already established fire ring!





Go Ahead 4 spaces

Girl Scouts practice fire safety

You didn't store your food properly and raccoons scattered it everywhere!





Go back 4 space

Girl Scouts know about animal safety

NO! NO! NO!

You threw a soda can in a stream while you were on a hike

Girl Scouts respect the environment

You watched the sunset with your troop and took it all in!





Go Ahead 2 spaces

Girl Scouts enjoy nature.

You learned to start a 1 match fire.





Go Ahead 6 spaces

Girl Scouts know how to survive!

Oh no!

Your group cut limbs off of trees to use in your fire.





Lose a Turn

Girl Scouts use firewood from the ground.

You and your troop stayed on the marked trails!





Go Ahead 4 spaces

Girl Scouts follow the rules of camp.

Everyone in your troop remembered their water bottle!





Go Ahead 3 spaces

Girl Scouts stay hydrated!

One of the girls in your troop was afraid of the dark during your camp out. You told her she was safe!

Girl Scouts take only pictures.

You made sure to take buddy to the latrine with you!

Go Ahead 4 spaces

Girl Scouts make sure they are safe.

You found a neat looking rock, but left it next to the trail for someone else to find!





Go Ahead 3 spaces

Girl Scouts leave nature where it is!

You brought your own firewood from home to a campsite faraway!





Go Back 1 space

Girl Scouts get firewood from their campsite

You dumped an entire bucket of water on your campfire to put it out.





Go Back 3 Spaces

Girl Scouts sprinkle water on their fire to put it out!

You saw a deer and quietly watched it from a distance.





Go Ahead 3 spaces

Girl Scouts respect wildlife!

You brought your smartphone to the campout and it rang in the middle of the night.





Go Back 8 spaces

Girl Scouts can disconnect from technology!

Your group kept your voices down when walking on trails
