
## Geocaching Patch Program

Get ready to participate in our council geocaching program and learn how to use a GPS unit in a nearby park. To receive this patch, you must find at least three geocaches and know how to navigate using the GPS unit. In addition to the main patch, there are also opportunities to earn three more bar patches to hone your new geocache hunting skills and enjoy the great outdoors!



To gain your Explorer bar you must:

- Find at least 10 geocaches (either GSOH or geocaching.com geocaches).
- Find caches in at least two different sites.
- Learn about geocaching.com and prepare to geocache at non-GSOH sites.



To gain your Adventurer bar you must:

- Find at least 20 geocaches total; the caches from your Explorer bar also count in this total.
- Find caches in at least three different sites.
- Plant a travel bug in a geocaching.com cache https://bit.ly/3uFp9mD.



To gain your Conqueror bar you must:

- Find at least 40 Geocaches total; caches from your Explorer and Adventurer bars also count in this total (they must be a combination of GSOH and geochaching.com geocaches).
- Find geocaches in at least five different sites.
- Plant a Geocache of your own and register your treasure on the site https://bit.ly/3o5tGwe.
