## **Bracelet Guidelines**

- Please make 2 matching friendship bracelets.
- Place each set in a small bag or envelope.
- Each bracelet should be large enough to fit an adult.
- Any style of bracelet is accepted! Be creative and use your imagination to create something beautiful.
- Use your resources wisely. Ask for donations for supplies or reuse materials from previous projects.
- Focus on the quality of the bracelets over the quantity.
- All completed friendship bracelets need to be delivered to any GSOH service center by April 17, 2024.
